Readfield Recreation Association Board of Trustees Duties of Officers and Active Members

The mission of the Readfield Recreation Association Board of Trustees is to provide self-supporting recreation and athletic program opportunities for the citizens of our community through the support of our volunteers.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Continue to support and expand town recreation and athletic programs.
- 2. Continue to encourage volunteer participation and improve coordination of volunteers.
- 3. Consider long-range public beach needs and explore the acquisition of additional shorefront area(s) for public use.
- 4. Explore opportunities to provide recreational access to the Augusta Watershed District lands surrounding Carleton Pond.

Duties:

- 1. Chair: Schedules and chairs Board of Trustees meetings, propose meeting agendas, communicates and coordinates activities with Municipal Officials and the Select Board.
- 2. Vice Chair: Would assume the duties of the Chair if the Chair is absent. Perform duties delegated by the Chair.
- 3. Secretary: Keeps/maintains the minutes of the meetings of the Board, provides information for Readfield Messenger articles and may handle other occasional correspondence.
- 4. Treasurer: maintains the financial log for the Board; serves as the liaison between the Board and the town Budget Committee; prepares and delivers the yearly budget.
- 5. Committee members:
 - a. Attend meetings, review proposals or items brought before the Board.
 - b. Work to coordinate and facilitate volunteer efforts for continued program opportunities.
 - c. Vote on agenda items when called for.
