Budget & Finance:

• I have addressed a number of tax issues over the past two weeks following the mailing of tax bills. Please let me know if there are any questions.

Solid Waste and Recycling:

- CDD removal for off-site grinding started last week.
- Over 100 Freon units were drained and we are ready to remove the metal.

Maintenance & Infrastructure:

- Roadside mowing is essentially complete. Some touch-up is needed. We are planning an earlier start next year.
- The first phase of road striping is complete. The second phase will take place after paving.

Personnel:

- Our cemetery Sexton attended a stone repair and cleaning workshop this past weekend.

- We have an opening for a part-time seasonal position to assist with Cemetery, Grounds, and Maintenance work. Applications are recommended to be in by September 2nd, but the position will be open until filled.
- I want to thank Casey Nadeau for his fill-in work in the Cemeteries and at the Transfer Station. It's good to have a flexible team member who is willing and able to step in wherever necessary.
- I am setting up project / task management software with one of our employees on a trial basis to see if there is a benefit to time management and work prioritization.
