Town Manager Report

June 7, 2021

Maintenance & Infrastructure:

- Road sweeping is underway.
- Paving on Plains Rd. and Sturtevant Hill Rd. is complete. Shoulder gravel will be applied this week. The intersection of Plains Rd. with Ratt Mill Hill and Gay Rd. received some extra attention.
- Striping and Crack Sealing service RFPs are in and up for discussion.
- Our mobile speed trailer has been put out for the season and will be rotated through several areas of town this summer.

Parks and Recreation:

- The Readfield Beach is officially open. Use of the beach is free to residents but a beach pass is still required.
- Thank you to our summer staff London Putnam, Morgan Boynton, and Noah Ward-Rubin. Special thanks to Noah, our Lead Beach Attendant, who received his lifeguard training this past weekend!
- We will be offering morning swim lessons this year in partnership with the Augusta YMCA. Lessons will most likely be from July through mid-August - more details will be available soon!

Transfer Station:

- We now have internet service at the Transfer Station.
- We have signed a contract with local company RNROS for a Point of Sale system at the Transfer Station. This system will allow for card processing and electronic recording of all transactions and improve operations and operational efficiency.
- We have made progress with preparing for our composting program and we expect a full roll-out this month.
- Hazardous Waste Collection Day will be Sunday, July 11th from 8-noon. Pre-registration is required.
- Sunday hours will run through the weekend before Labor Day, excluding the 4th of July. Sunday hours are 8am to Noon.

Administration & Personnel

- The Town Meeting / Secret Ballot vote is tomorrow, June 8, 2021 from 8am to 8pm at the Alford Athletic Center at Kents Hill. Masks are recommended but not required. Special thanks to Kents Hill School for the use of their facility, and to all of our Elections Staff for their work.
