- 5. Roughly \$12,000.00 over budget; \$6,000.00 for Readfield, \$3,000.00 each for Fayette and Wayne which is about 5% over budget. Fayette has their June payment of \$7,400.00 and \$8,600 for Wayne for the final payment of the fiscal year.
