Readfield Trails Committee Minutes February 27, 2018

Don Rahmlow demonstrated the state RSMS software as a possible way to map our trails. The software is written to help towns with their road maintenance, but it can be adapted to trails. Readfield owns a copy, so there is no cost to trails

Greg L. suggested that a smaller group of members be formed to work with Don on deciding how to proceed, such as what we want to highlight on the maps.

Greg L. updated us on what is happening with the Conservation Commission and the possibility of installing solar power via Revision. They considered the Fairgrounds and old landfill, but there were issues. They are continuing to look at options, including the schools.

Greg D. and Ken met with the Budget Committee regarding Trails' expenses and budget. The budget was intact as of that meeting.

Nancy asked if there were any updates on the Draper property. Greg L. said the New England Forestry Foundation has new leadership and will undoubtedly be looking into trails.

The next meeting will be March 27.
